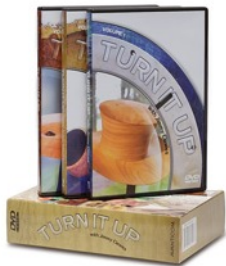

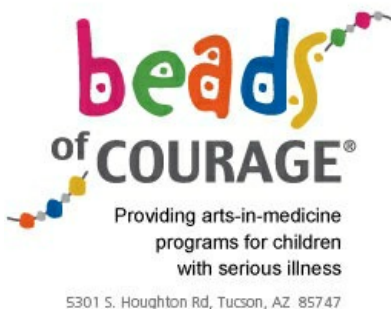

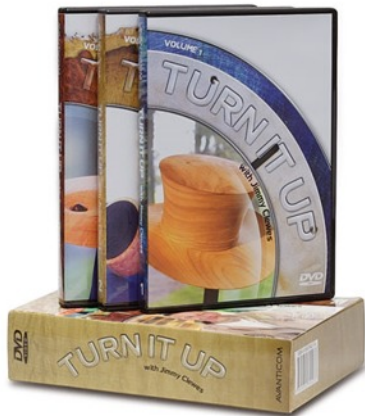
2012 Membership Drive
