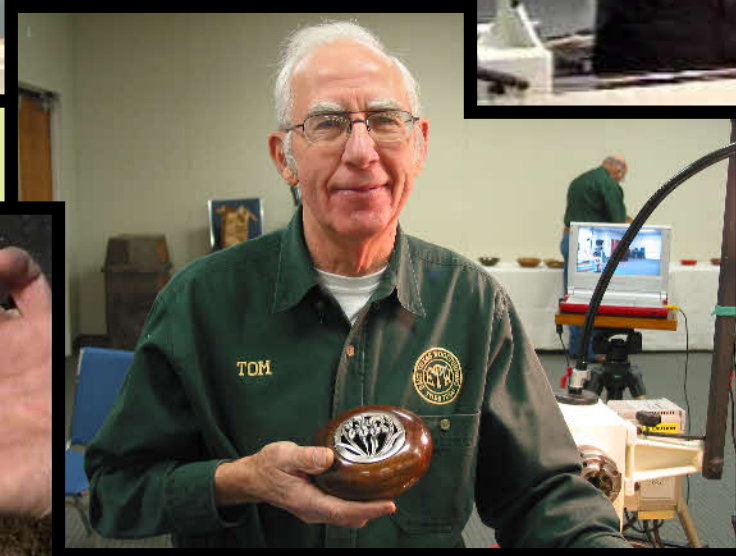

The SouthWest Association of Turners (SWAT) will be holding its annual symposium on October 16-19, 2009 in Wichita Falls, TX. For those of who are not familiar with this activity, I'll give a brief explanation. SWAT consists of about 24 turning clubs from Texas and Oklahoma. Volunteers from those clubs do a tremendous job of providing a venue where six international turners and twelve regional (Texas/Oklahoma) turners perform a total of (I think) 54 demonstrations over the three day period. All of this opportunity for only \$125.00. There will be a banquet on Saturday night which you won't want to miss. All kinds of raffle items will be given away (yeah, you gotta buy tickets). But, you will have two opportunities to win! Donated items are raffled at the banquet then those winners' tickets go back into the drum for another chance to win a new lathe on Sunday.
